APPENDIX A - ELIGIBILITY EVIDENCE REQUIREMENTS

Valid Identification

CADTR requires government-issued identification to confirm your identity. Expired identification will not be accepted. If your current name is different from the name displayed on your identification provided and/or documents submitted to CADTR, you will be required to provide a copy of your marriage certificate or legal change of name document.

The following forms of government-issued identification are accepted:

- Driver's License Issued in Canada
- Canadian Passport
- Non-Canadian Passport (translated if not English/French)
- Permanent Resident Card

A minimum education level equivalent to that of high school or secondary education in Canada

- If you completed formal post-secondary education in a program not related to dental health in Canada or outside of Canada, have the credential assessed by a Designated Credential Assessment (DCA) organization and have the report sent directly by the DCA to CADTR. (Option of five DCA's as already accepted by CADTR)
- If you did not complete formal post-secondary education in a program not related to dental health in or
 outside of Canada but obtained a secondary/high school or equivalent diploma in or outside of Canada or
 have results from an accepted high school equivalency test, have your high school diploma, or Adult Basic
 Education (ABE) certificate, or high school equivalency test result assessed by a DCA and have them send
 the report directly to CADTR.
 - Accepted high school equivalency tests and results include:
 - The Canadian Adult Education Credential (CAEC)
 - The General Educational Development (GED)

At least five (5) years or a minimum of 6500 hours of verifiable work experience in dental technology, of which one (1) year or a minimum of 1300 hours is obtained within the last 36 months prior to time of application.

- Completed Work Experience and Hours Form with workplace contact details and option for CADTR to verify.
- At least **one reference letter** obtained from a supervisor, colleague or another dental technology professional preferably from the most recent work experience, sent directly to CADTR that attests to:
 - Applicant has gained work and learning experience related to dental technology and their confidence/readiness for having met the required competencies
 - Having completed at least one (1) year or a minimum of 1300 hours obtained no longer than 36 months prior to time of application
